What Are Transfr VR Headsets?

Transfr is a VR-based platform that lets learners safely explore careers, practice job skills, and build confidence through immersive, real-world simulations.

Who Are Transfr VR Headsets For?

- 4th-12th graders: Career exploration, pathway awareness, and engagement
- Adult learners and job seekers: Workforce readiness and skills exposure
- School staff: Instructional and career development support
- Special populations: Accessible, low-risk exposure to careers and job skills

Helpful Tips for Setup & Use

Space Requirements:

- Clear, open area free of obstacles.
- Recommended minimum of 5X5 feet per user. 6X6 feet is ideal.
- Libraries and large classrooms are great spaces to hold VR simulations.

Time Considerations:

- Plan for orientation procedures and rotation time (15-20 minutes per group).
- Establish clear rotation procedures for multiple users.
- All headsets are sanitized and cleaned after each use.

Power & Charging:

- Headsets are battery-powered but require regular charging.
- Nearby electrical outlets or charging stations are required.

Connectivity:

- The CCD team will provide two MiFi devices to support internet connectivity.
